Tools needed :

- Adhesive
- Paper trimmer/ scissors
- ½" circle punch
- Foam Squares
- Twine
- Glitter
- Burlap

Instructions:

Step 1: Trim Flurry paper to 11 ½ x 11 ½".

Step 2: From left side of Caroling paper, cut a 2 ½" x 9 ½" piece. Use a ½" circle punch to create the 'stamp' edge. Adhere Caroling piece to the Flurry piece, ½" in from left edge and 1 ½" down from top edge.

Step 3: Cut Evergreen 2 x 9 ½", adhere on top of Caroling, right sides flush.

Step 4: With stamp design up, cut lengthwise from right side of Stamps paper a 8 ½" x 2 ½" piece. Attach to Evergreen piece with music notes up, as shown.

Step 5: Cut Paprika Dot 5 ½" x 7 ½" and use ½" circle punch on all edges to create postage stamp look. Adhere on top of Stamps paper, 1" in from Stamps left edge and ½" from Stamps bottom edge.

Step 6: Create photo mat with a 4 ½" x 6 ½" piece of Caroling. Place in center of Paprika rectangle and attach photo.

Step 7: Banner- Fussy cut 3 stamps out of remaining Stamps paper and place in top right corner with twine running behind. Tuck twine behind Flurry page and then mount to the 12 x 12" Paprika Dot base.

Step 8: Add glitter paste to flourishes and place as shown. Use foam squares to attach Noteworthy Stamp piece. Cover chipboard letters J-O-Y with Stamps paper and attach with foam squares as shown.

Step 9: Cut Santa from Caroling paper and attach to 3" circle of burlap and then to page. Add glitter paste as desired.

Step 10: Refer to photo for placement of washi tape, jewels, chipboard, etc.

Designer tips :

- Try using sepia photos on vintage layouts; it creates an 'old feel'.
- When adhering photos onto your layouts, leave edges free of tape so that you can slide Noteworthy pieces and other embellishments underneath later.
